Frequently Asked Questions

Legal Requirements

You will need to bring original copies of the following documentation - photocopies are not acceptable

- Full birth certificate (short versions are not accepted).
- 10 year passport (must have at least 3 months remaining following your return to the UK)
- If either of you are divorced, your decree absolute (original copies of the divorce papers). If this document is not in English it must be translated to English or Greek and signed by a notary and this as well as the original document are required.
- If either of you are widowed, your late spouse's death certificate and any previous marriage certificate
- If either of you are adopted, your adoption certificate
- If either of you are under 18 years of age, a letter of consent from a parent or guardian
- If either of you have changed your name by deed poll, proof from a solicitor is required

For an Anglican church wedding at least one person must have a baptism certificate, but for Catholic church weddings both of you must have baptism certificates, which you may be asked to show at your church meeting

A statutory declaration for UK passport holders (one per person) must be obtained from a solicitor in the UK, stating that you are free to marry. This must be obtained no earlier than three months prior to the date of your wedding.

A statutory declaration (affidavit) is a legal document declaring that the person named is single, free and entitled to marry. This document may be obtained from a Solicitor in the UK and must be stamped and signed by the Solicitor.

Irish passport holders must obtain a 'freedom to marry' certificate from the Irish Embassy in England or the Department of Foreign Affairs in Ireland.

If you hold a passport which is not from the UK or Ireland then you must speak to the Cypriot embassy or consulate in your country to establish what documentation you will require instead of the statutory declaration.

How many days do we have to be in Cyprus before we can be married?

If you are having a civil ceremony you should be in Cyprus for at least 3 working days prior to your ceremony – this does not include the day you arrive or weekends.

If you are having a church ceremony at least 5 working days.

Are we able to get married at the weekend?

Ceremonies are only performed Monday to Friday in Cyprus.

How we rate venues

Our wedding venues ratings system is based on 5 stars, 5 being the most highly recommended option. What we do is look at the venue itself, its immediate surroundings and the ease of getting to the venue from hotels or surrounding villas. Example:

A venue might be close to the sea, but it might be located next to a large hotel or possibly even a main road which in our minds affects the ambience to a degree. Whilst the venue itself might be stunning, it might not be in the ideal location. A 5 star rating means the venue is ideal, that it is located in stunning surroundings and it is convenient for you and your group to get to and from without necessarily needing public, private or paid transport.
